

Alaska Airlines Boosts BWI Marshall Airport Service

New Service Between BWI Marshall and Los Angeles to Start in September

Alaska Airlines announced today that it would begin daily service between Baltimore/Washington International Thurgood Marshall Airport (BWI Marshall) and Los Angeles International Airport (LAX). The flights are scheduled to depart Los Angeles each night at 10:10 p.m. with a 6:15 a.m. arrival the next day at BWI Marshall. The BWI Marshall to LAX flight is scheduled to depart at 7:30 a.m. with a 10:40 a.m. arrival in Los Angeles. Flight times are based on local time zones. The first flight will operate from LAX on September 9; the first BWI Marshall arrival and departure are scheduled for September 10.

“This added service from Alaska Airlines is excellent news for our travelers,” said Paul J. Wiedefeld, Chief Executive Officer for BWI Marshall Airport. “Alaska Airlines is highly regarded for its outstanding customer service and travel product. We continue working to add new flight options and more value for our customers.”

Alaska Airlines first started service at BWI Marshall in September 2014 with daily nonstop service to the airline’s hub in Seattle. Alaska will fly the new daily roundtrip service between BWI Marshall and LAX on its next generation Boeing 737 aircraft. The airline offers flights to markets across the Lower 48 states, Alaska, Hawaii, Mexico, and Canada.
